

Quality Assurance and CPE

Did you know that Quality Assurance is an approved activity for Continuing Professional Education (CPE)?

Under the IPPF, each CAE is required to establish a Quality Assurance and Improvement program. This program should include both internal and external assessments, and the results of the program should be reported annually to senior management and the Board.

To utilise quality assessment activities for CPE purposes, CAEs should formally document their Quality Assurance and Improvement Program. Structured activities like peer review of working papers, customer feedback surveys and interviews could then all be counted towards CPE.

Given that a range of CPE activities are required to be undertaken by members, it would be reasonable for up to 20 hours of CPE to be allocated each two year period to formalised and structured quality assurance activities.
